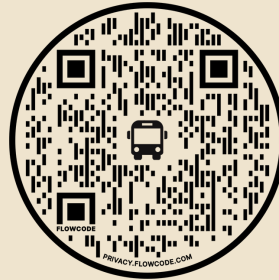
VT Free Public Wifi Map



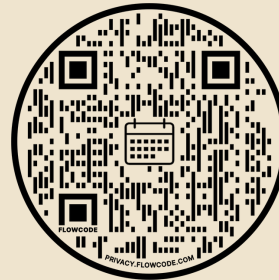
Google Map of Locations
